BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- **Transportation Claims:** Valley's responsibility for shipping damages ends once the product is delivered in good condition to the carrier. Any claims for transport-related damage must be filed directly with the carrier.
- **Compliance:** Review your local building codes to ensure the installation complies with applicable regulations.

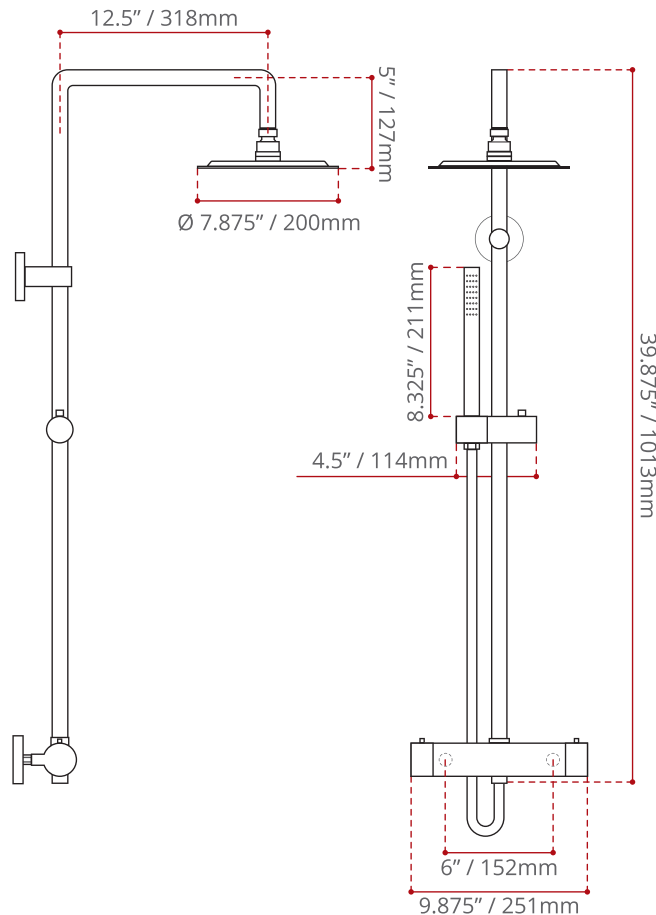

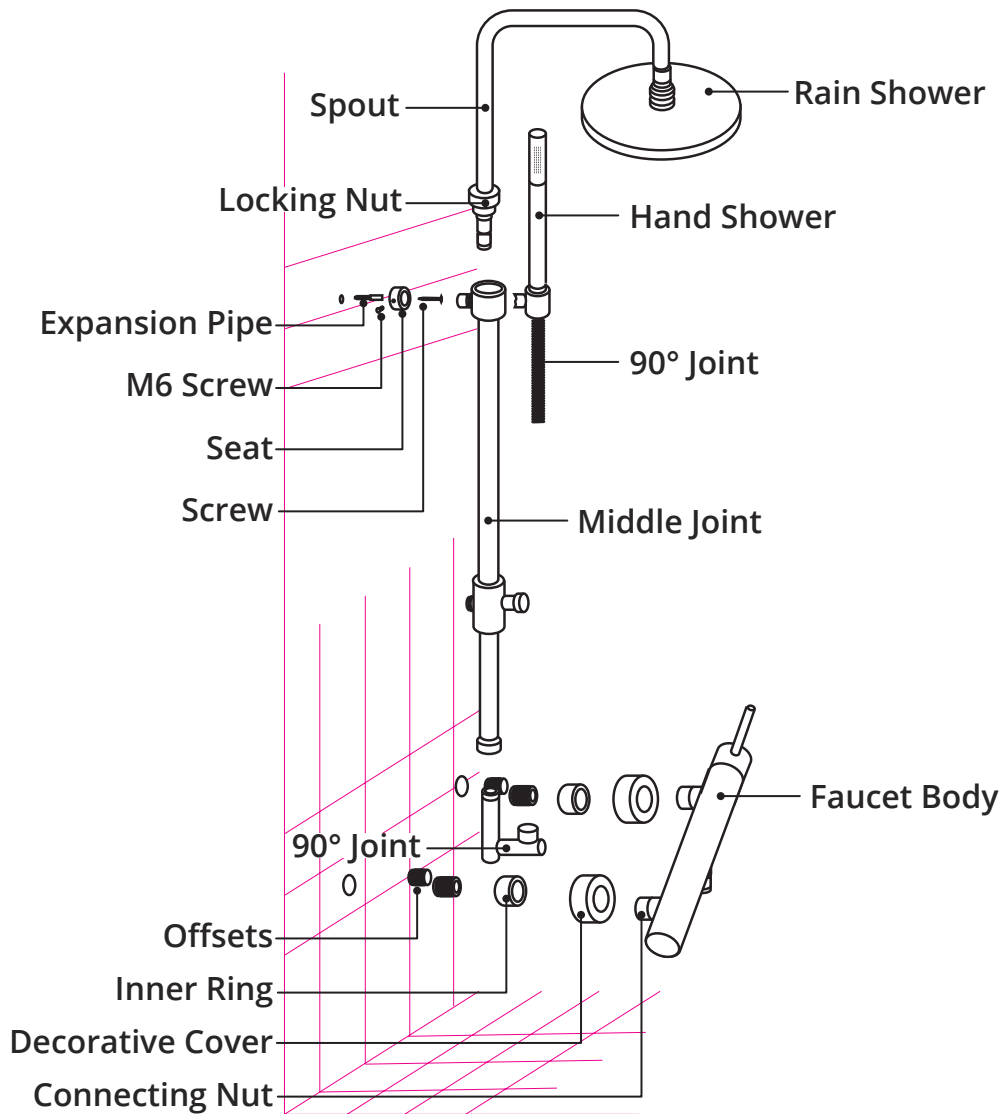


Important Notes Before Installation

- Before assembly, flush the water supply pipes thoroughly. Allow the water to run for at least 3 minutes with the main stopcock fully open. This step is essential to remove any dirt, sand, or debris that could impair the performance of the faucet or shower system.
- Install the water supply pipes according to this manual.
- Position the floor drain at the faucet installation location.
- Install the faucet after all decoration/painting is completed (paint fumes may corrode the faucet surface).
- Ensure the water pipes are clear of mud, sand, or other debris before installation.
- Wrap the threaded parts with sealing (PTFE) tape before screwing. Place a cloth between the wrench and faucet to prevent scratches. Do not overtighten; forcing threads may damage the faucet.
- After installation, confirm all connections are secure. Connect the water supply, test by turning on and off repeatedly, and check for leaks.

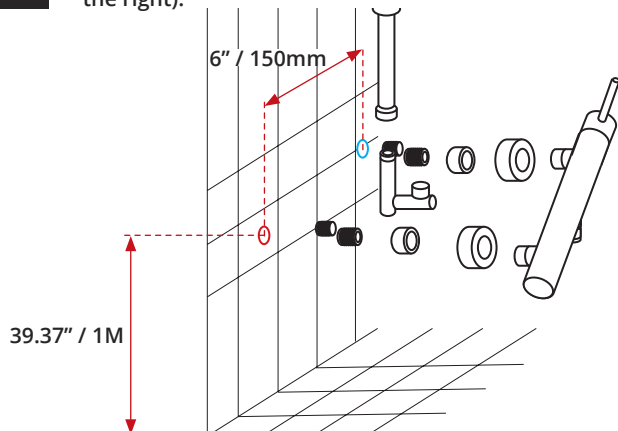

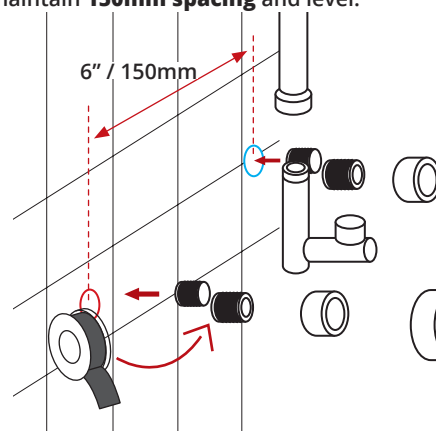

Install hot and cold water pipes **1 meter above the ground**, spaced **150mm apart** (hot on the left, cold on the right).



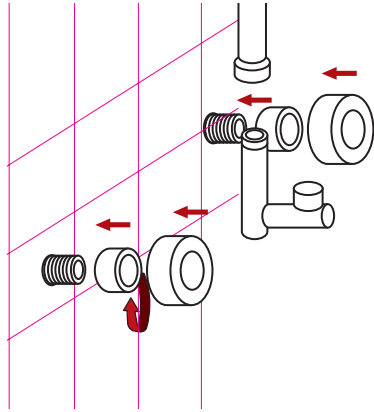

Wrap sealing tape around the two offset connectors. Tighten onto pipe joints with a wrench. Adjust to maintain **150mm spacing** and level.



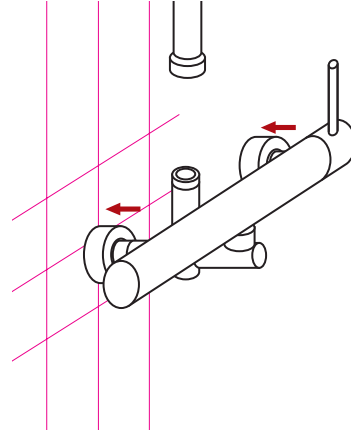

Screw inner connecting rings onto the offsets (threads facing outward). Slide the decorative covers in place, bell side facing inward, flush against the wall.



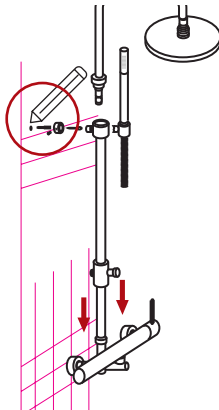

Connect the faucet's nuts to the offsets and tighten. Push the decorative covers firmly against the wall.



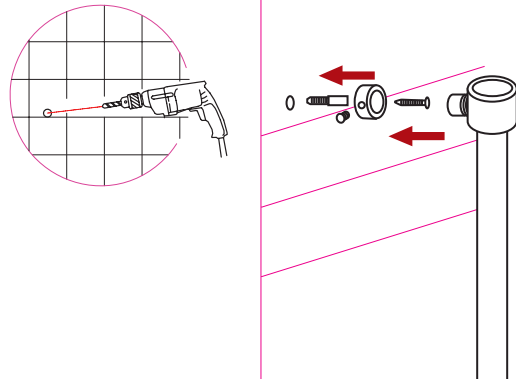

Connect the faucet body to the middle joint with the 90° connector. Hold it vertically against the wall and mark the upper seat position.

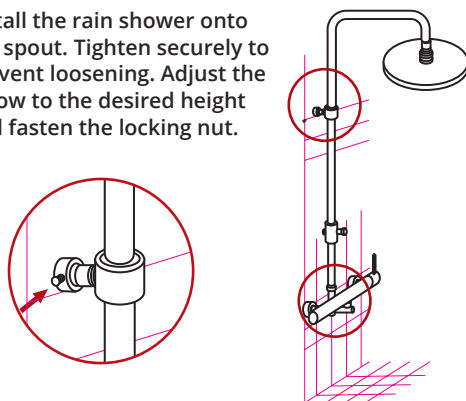
Remove the middle joint. Drill an 8mm hole at the marked spot, insert an expansion plug, and fix the seat to the wall with the provided screw.

Insert the elbow into the middle joint. Connect the lower end to the 90° pipe and tighten. Secure the upper end to the seat with an M6 screw.

Install the rain shower onto the spout. Tighten securely to prevent loosening. Adjust the elbow to the desired height and fasten the locking nut.

Connect the hand shower hose. Attach to water source and test installation for proper function and leaks.
