

#### TOP VIEW



#### WALL MOUNT FAUCET




#### SIDE VIEW

### SUGGESTED DIMENSIONS







IF USING FAUCET MODULE, MAKE SURE TO PROPERLY FLUSH THE HOT AND COLD WATER SUPPLY LINES PRIOR TO STARTING INSTALLATION.

## BASIN INSTALLATION GUIDE

- 01** Place the bracket against the wall using a level in order to verify exact position and mark the slot centre with a pencil.




- 02** Where marked, pierce the wall with drill and put supplied plugs/anchors into the wall.




## BASIN INSTALLATION GUIDE

- 03** Place the bracket against the wall again. Use the level and fix the bracket screwing till the bracket is perfectly fixed.





- 04** - Apply a thin layer of teflon on the threads of the pipe (2) and screw the pipe to the drain base (1). Assemble the drain to the hole of the sink using the clamping ring kit (3).

**NOTE:** Drain not included. We recommend our **A131Q** Open grid drain or our **A9290** Open grid drain with cap .


**05** Put the MIMI basin into the bracket



**06** - We recommend using a flexible P-TRAP. It is advisable to insert the flexible P-TRAP on the hose along the drain assembly. Then adjust the height of the outlet pipe of the flexible P-TRAP along the height of the plumbing wall. Ⓐ



- Position the sink to the wall at a distance sufficient to allow assembly of the flexible P-TRAP plumbing.

**NOTE:** Drain not included. We recommend our **A131Q** Open grid drain or our **A9290** Open grid drain with cap .






## WALL MOUNT FAUCET INSTALLATION GUIDE

- 01** Lean the shelf against the wall using a level in order to verify exact position and mark the two 2 3/8 holeslot centre with a pencil.




- 02** Where marked, pierce the wall with drill and put supplied plugs/anchors into the wall.




## WALL MOUNT FAUCET INSTALLATION GUIDE


- 03** Screw flex hoses and fix it to faucet. Position the faucet into place.



- 04** Connect flexible hoses to the water stop outlet as shown.



**05** Fix the cover to the shelf using supplied screws.  
**ATTENTION:** do not tighten screws excessively.



## WARRANTY INFORMATION

All Valley Acrylic Bath Ltd. products are covered under a warranty period of one year, and only extend to the original owner; in other words, the warranty on Valley Acrylic Bath Ltd products is not transferable. You must provide a Proof of Purchase for warranty to be considered valid.

Lifetime Warranty on faucet cartridge and 1 year warranty on faucet finish.

Warranty is immediately voided if products or equipment are not installed or operated in accordance with instructions supplied by Valley Acrylic Bath LTD.

Damage caused by wear and tear, abuse, carelessness, accident or misuse of the product will not be covered under our warranty. Warranty also does not apply to stains or malfunctions caused by corrosive chemicals or other such materials.

Any labor charges incurred by the purchase to repair, replace, install or remove product are not covered by this warranty.

### Cleaning & Care:

For both finishes you can use normal household cleaners (anything ammonia-based) or just use warm soapy water and a non-abrasive household sponge, etc. or a commercially available stone resin (solid surface) cleaner to remove most residues. **DO NOT** use anything acidic as it could damage the finish. Neither of our finishes should stain easily with normal regular cleaning.

Shila Stone is known for its strong, long lasting heat retention. The Glossy finish is a tad easier to clean due to the sleekness of it. All in all both finishes are very durable and if you do happen to scratch the surface, the beauty of stone resin is that you can sand it right out and it looks good as new. If this happens to the Glossy finish, after you sand the scratch out, you need to reapply the gloss finish.
