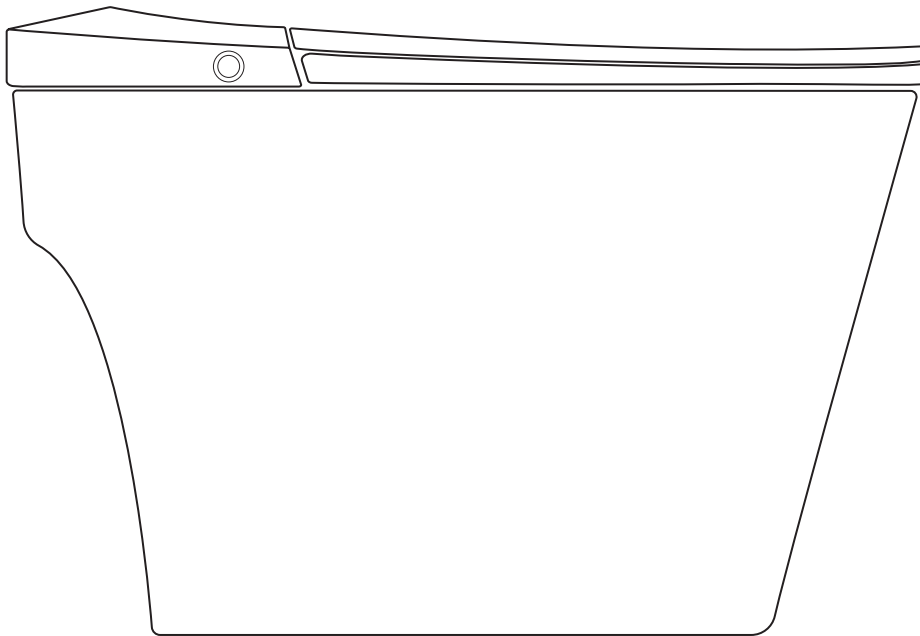

This guide provides important information for the safe and proper installation of your smart toilet. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Read this manual completely before starting installation.
- Ensure installation complies with all local plumbing and electrical codes.
- Carefully remove the unit from its packaging and inspect it for damage.
- Do not install the product if any damage or defects are found. Contact your place of purchase immediately.

Important:

Damage to the finish or product after installation is not covered under warranty. Valley Bath & Kitchen is not responsible for shipping damage once the product has been delivered to the carrier in good condition. Any shipping damage claims must be filed directly with the carrier.

- It is recommended to place the toilet in the bathroom prior to installation to confirm fit and positioning.
- Keep all hardware, nuts, and bolts until installation is complete.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Read and follow all safety instructions carefully. Failure to do so may result in fire, electric shock, injury, or property damage.

WARNING

- Do not touch the electrical outlet with wet hands.
- Do not pour water, hot water, or cleaning agents onto the toilet body or electrical components.
- Do not disassemble or attempt to repair the product yourself.

- Use only tap water or potable well water.

Immediately Disconnect Power and Shut Off Water If:

- The seat becomes loose or detached

Continuing to use the toilet under these conditions may result in fire, electric shock, short circuit, injury, or water damage.

Low-Temperature Scalding Warning

Extended use of the heated seat at high temperature may cause low-temperature burns.

If seated for long periods:

- Reduce the seat temperature
- Turn off the seat heating function if necessary

Electrical Safety

- This product must be installed in a dry, well-ventilated environment.
- Do not install in areas exposed to excessive moisture.
- If installed in a bathroom, ensure proper ventilation is available.

The unit must be properly grounded. Improper grounding may result in electric shock.

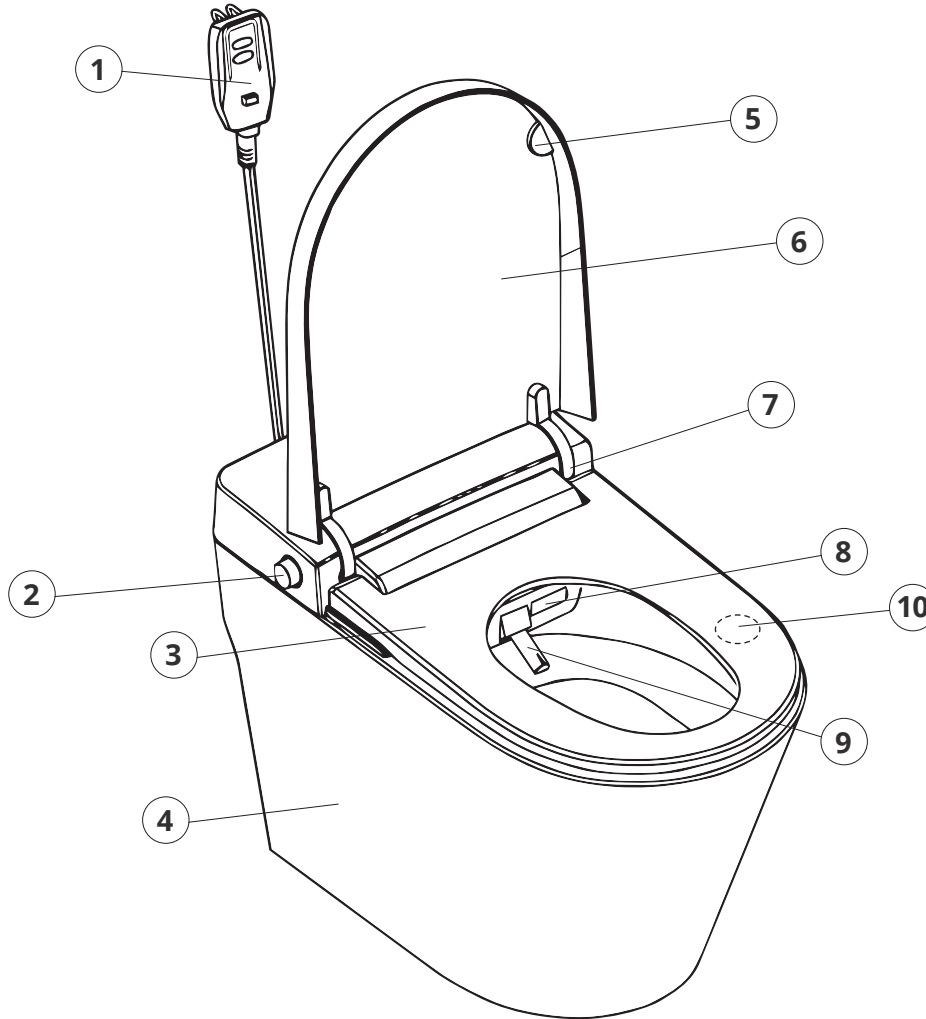
Confirm that the outlet meets the following requirements:

- a) Protected by a high-sensitivity GFCI (15mA or lower), or installed with an appropriate isolation transformer (1.5kVA–3kVA).
- b) Located away from bathtubs and wet zones.

If unsure, consult a licensed electrician.

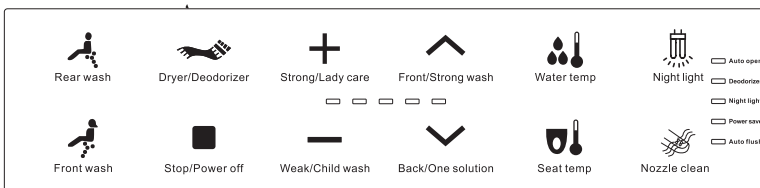

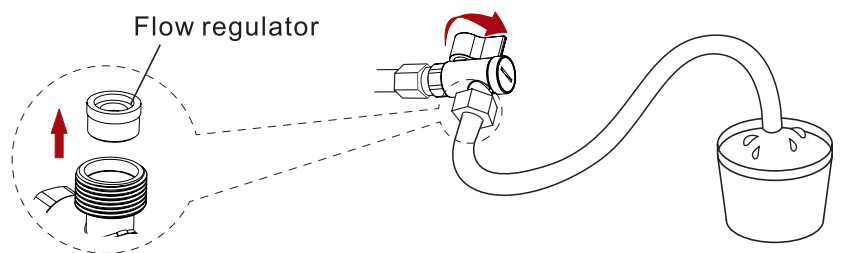
01 PREPARE AND INSTALL THE SUPPLY STOP ADAPTER

1. Locate the existing shut-off valve (supply stop).
2. Turn the valve fully ON and allow water to run for approximately 60 seconds. This flushes debris from the line that could damage internal components.
3. Turn the valve fully OFF.
4. If replacing the supply stop, remove the old valve according to plumbing standards.
5. Apply thread sealing tape (Teflon tape) clockwise to the exposed 1/2" NPT male water supply pipe threads. Wrap 3–5 full turns, starting at the second thread to prevent tape from entering the water line.
6. Thread the supplied adapter onto the pipe. Ensure the directional arrow on the adapter points toward the toilet.
7. Tighten by hand until snug, then tighten an additional 1–2 turns with a wrench.
8. Do not overtighten. Excessive force may crack fittings or damage threads.



02 VERIFY WATER FLOW AND PRESSURE

1. Attach a hose and direct it into a bucket (minimum 3 gallons / 11.4L). If no hose is available, cover the outlet with a cloth and direct water into a bucket.
2. Turn on the supply stop.
3. Confirm that at least 1 gallon of water flows within 10 seconds.
4. If water pressure is insufficient, remove the flow regulator or install a booster pump.
5. Turn off the supply stop and remove the hose.



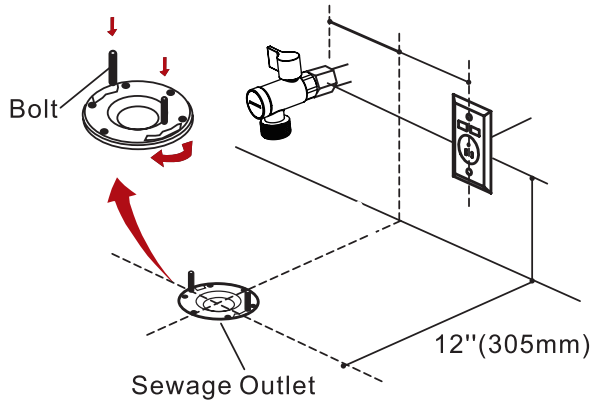


IF THE ROUGH-IN (DISTANCE FROM FINISHED WALL TO CENTER OF DRAIN OUTLET) IS LESS THAN 12" (305MM), THE TOILET LID MAY CONTACT THE WALL WHEN OPENED.



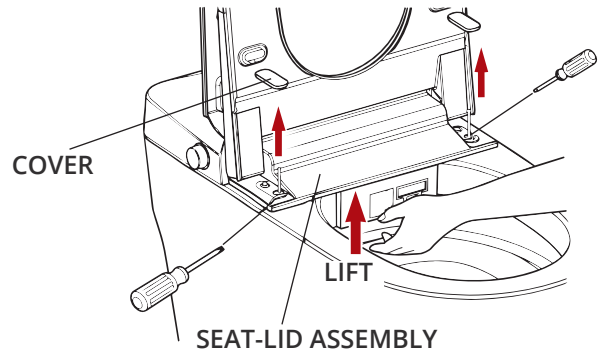
03 INSTALL TOILET FLANGE (NEW INSTALLATIONS ONLY)

Install toilet flange according to plumbing standards. Insert flange bolts.



04 REMOVE THE SEAT-LID ASSEMBLY

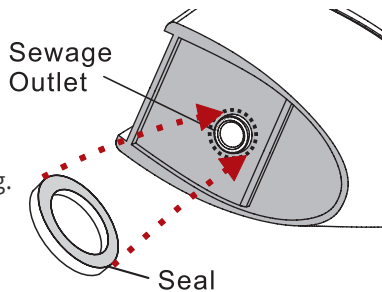
Remove the decorative screw covers and unscrew the long mounting screws. Lift the seat-lid assembly straight up from the base.



05 INSTALL SEALING RING

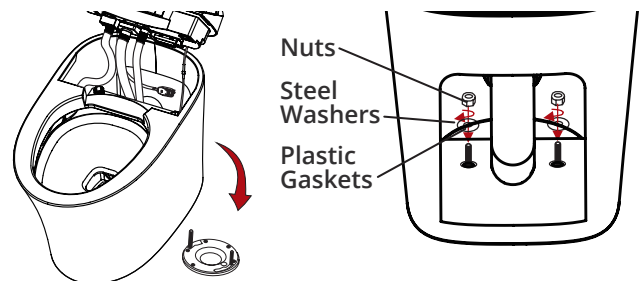
1. Turn the toilet upside down carefully on protective padding.
2. Position the sealing ring evenly around the discharge outlet.
3. Ensure the ring sits flat and centered.
4. Do not stretch or deform the sealing ring.

Improper placement may result in leakage.

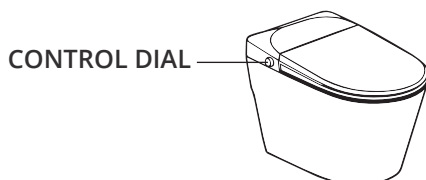
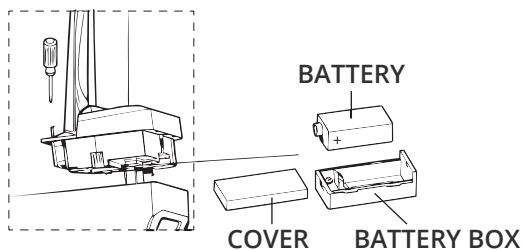


06 POSITION AND SECURE TOILET

1. Carefully place the toilet onto the flange.
2. Ensure bolts align with the mounting holes.
3. Install washers and nuts.
4. Tighten evenly using a wrench. Do not overtighten.



07 INSTALL BACKUP BATTERY



1. Remove the battery compartment cover.
2. Insert alkaline batteries.
3. Replace the cover securely.
4. Press the control dial on the side to confirm flushing function.

NOTE:

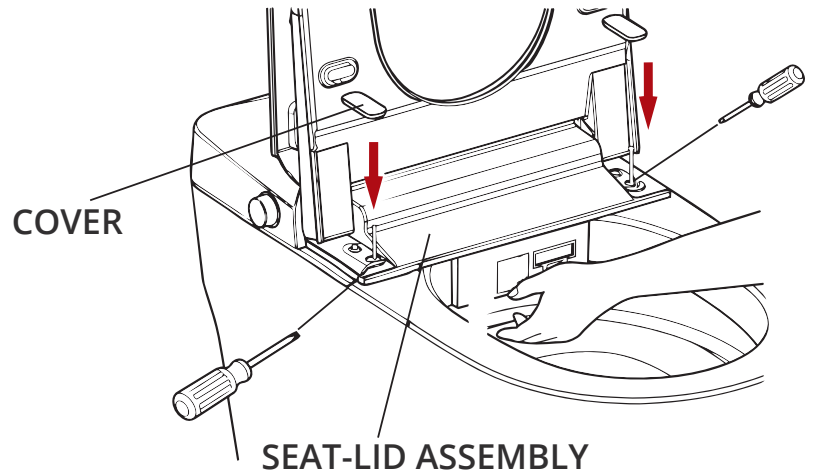
- Use alkaline batteries only.
- Batteries provide flushing capability during power failure.
- Dispose of used batteries at a designated recycling center.

08 REINSTALL SEAT-LID ASSEMBLY

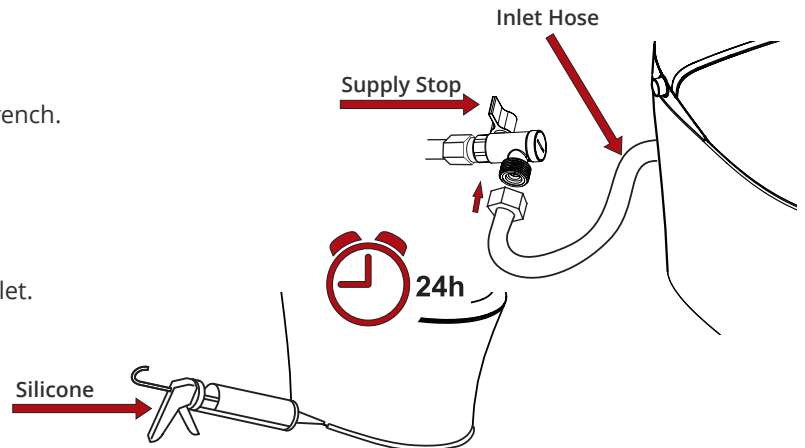
Reinstall the seat-lid assembly and secure screws and covers.

NOTE: Do not force or apply excessive pressure. seat-lid assembly.



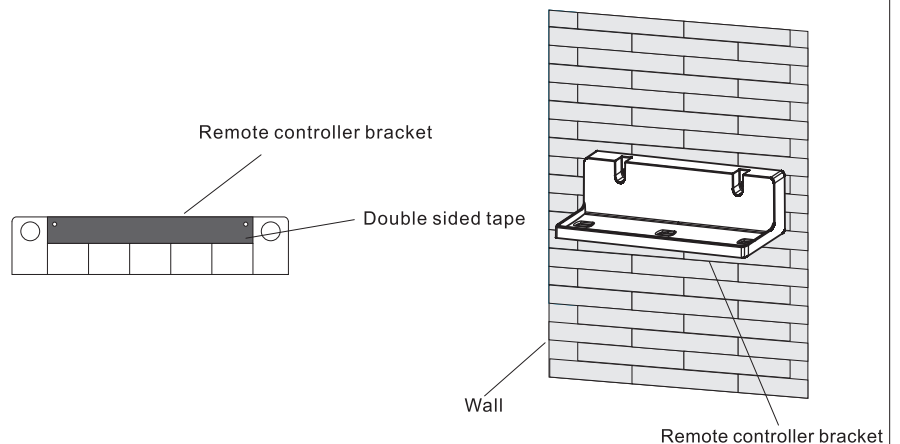
09 CONNECT WATER SUPPLY

1. Connect the water inlet hose to the supply stop.
2. Hand-tighten first, then tighten slightly with a wrench.
3. Turn on the supply stop.
4. Check all connections for leaks.
5. Apply silicone sealant around the base of the toilet.
6. Allow 24 hours curing time before use.



10 INSTALL REMOTE BRACKET

1. Clean the wall surface thoroughly.
2. Remove the backing from the double-sided tape.
3. Press the bracket firmly and evenly onto the wall.
4. Allow adhesive to set for 15 minutes before use.

REAR WASH

Press , nozzle reaches out to work. Press again, it changes to rear oscillating cleansing, the indicator#1 blink on remote control, nozzle repeatedly swings back or front. Press again, stops oscillating cleansing, it switches back to rear wash.



FRONT WASH

Press , nozzle reaches out to work; Press again, it changes to front oscillating cleansing, the indicator#1 blink on remote control, nozzle repeatedly swings back or front. Press again to stop oscillating cleansing, it switches back to front wash.

STOP



Stop the current cleaning operation. If do not press the stop button, rear washing/ front washing will stop automatically after 2 min. Press this button for 3sec. to turn it off

DRYER

Press , to start warm air drying. Press again change to removable air drying, swings back or front. Press again to stop.


NOTE: Under removable drying, the dryer position adjustment is unavailable

NIGHT LIGHT

Press this button to turn on the light, press again to close the light, and the corresponding light on the right will be on or off simultaneously. Repeatable switching.

When you turn on auto flush, smart toilet will flush firstly before you press drying

Deodorizer will turn off when under drying function. The deodorizer will auto-open when drying finished and it will keep working for 1.5 minutes when people leave the toilet seat.



STOP

Turn off the drying function. Or the warm air will stop automatically after running for 4 minutes.

NOZZLE CLEAN





Press this button to enter nozzle cleaning, then water flows out and you can clean the nozzle.







MAINTENANCE

SURFACE CLEANING

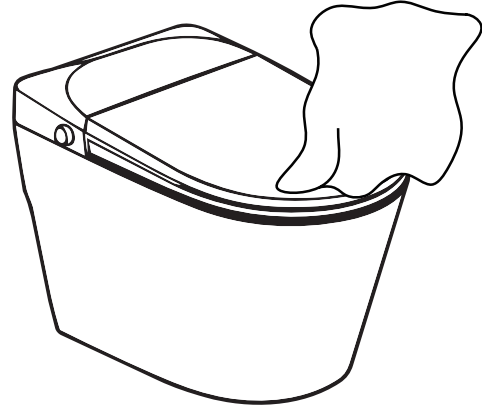
⚠ Always disconnect the power plug before cleaning. ⚠

Clean with a soft sponge or cloth and diluted mild detergent (soapy water).

Do NOT use:

- Acidic cleaners (hydrochloric acid, etc.)
- Paint thinner or benzene
- Abrasive pads or sandpaper
- Polishing agents
- Fragrance sprays or insecticides

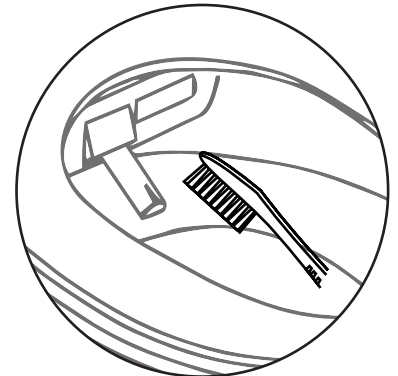
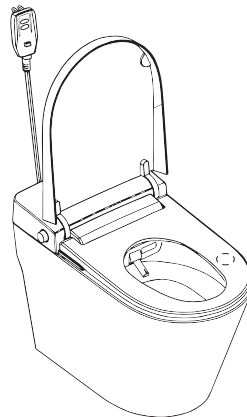

NOZZLE CLEANING

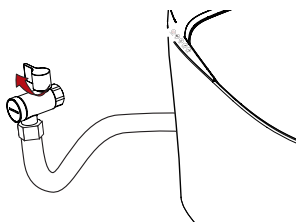
⚠ Attention: Do not use steel brush to clean ⚠

1. Press "Nozzle Clean."
2. The nozzle will extend and rinse automatically.
3. Clean gently with a soft cloth, sponge, or toothbrush.



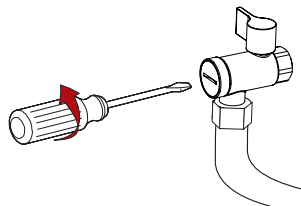
FILTER CLEANING

1. Close the valve and stop the water supply

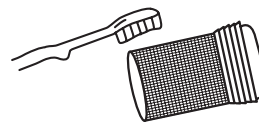


Attention: Do not remove the filter without closing the angle valve. Otherwise water will spray out.

2. Remove the filter.
Unscrew the cover of the filter with a screwdriver and pull it out as shown

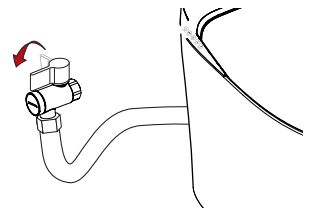


3. Clean the filter.
Get the filter out and clean it thoroughly. Flush off dirt or clean the filter with a toothbrush



Attention: Do not use any cleaning agents. Clean it with water only. Do not crush the filter when cleaning.

4. Reattach the filter.



Attention: Open the valve and make sure there is no water leakage.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

BACK-UP BATTERY

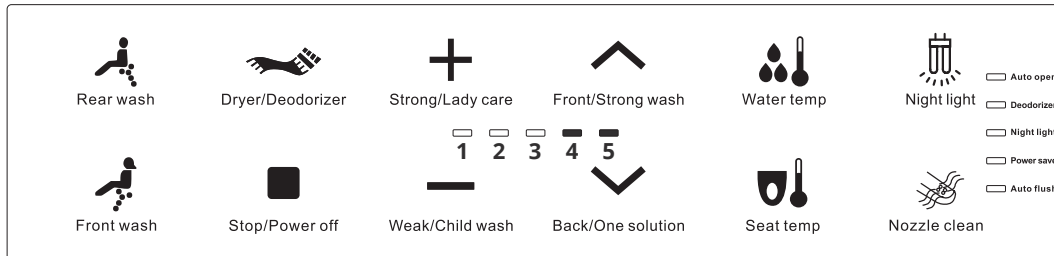
1. Unplug the power cord from the electrical outlet.
2. Remove the seat-lid assembly (refer to Installation Steps 4 and 7).
3. Remove the battery compartment cover.
4. Remove the old battery.
5. Install a new 9V alkaline battery, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
6. Press the flush button to confirm proper operation.
7. Reinstall the battery cover.
8. Reinstall the seat-lid assembly (refer to Installation Step 9).

TROUBLESHOOTING

ISSUES	CAUSE	SOLUTION
NO POWER	The electrical outlet is not connected to power supply or the plug is not inserted to the bottom	Check if the electrical outlet is connected to the power supply; press the reset key on the plug
NO WATER COMES OUT WHILE CLEANING	Low pressure of water supply	Raise the water pressure
	Water inlet filter blocked	Remount and clean the filter according to the instruction
CLEANSING WATER IS NOT WARM ENOUGH	Water temp setting is incorrect	Readjust
SEAT DOES NOT HEAT	Seat temp setting is incorrect or the toilet is in power saving mode	Readjust
SEAT AND COVER ARE LOOSE	Fixed bolts are loose	Tighten the bolts
REMOTE CONTROLLER FAILURE	Battery ran out	Replace battery
NO RESPONSE WHEN PRESSING THE KEY	Key fault	Reboot
WATER LEAKAGE	Shutoff valve, check water supply hose and water separator they might not be well connected	Reconnect/connet properly



HOW TO PAIR YOUR RR-S99WHT CONTROLLER

1 Press the **TEST** button to **turn OFF** the VA-S99WHT/VA-S66MBLK Smart Toilet.

2 Press the **STOP / POWER OFF** button to **turn ON** the RR-S99WHT Remote Controller.

3 Press and hold both the **WEAK/CHILD WASH** and **BACK/ONE SOLUTION** buttons at the same time for **3 seconds**.

As soon as the indicator lights begin to blink, press the **RESET** button to **turn ON** the VA-S99WHT/VA-S66MBLK Smart Toilet.

5 Pairing is complete. Your RR-S99WHT Remote Controller is now successfully connected to your VA-S99WHT/VA-S66MBLK Smart Toilet.
